



2019 OUTING INFORMATION AND FEES

Thank you for interest in hosting your outing at the Rolling Hills Country Club. Please review the following 2019 Guidelines and pricing that pertain to outings at the Club.

Reservations: Please contact Hilary Perettine, Director of Marketing and Sales, at 203-762-4604 or hperettine@rhconline.com to reserve a date.

Monday Outings are only reserved with a guarantee of 72 golfers; this is the minimum billed. Outings are required to submit a \$5,000 deposit to secure a date.

Approval Process: Outing approvals are based upon the number of participants, club staffing, course maintenance schedules and member convenience. The number of participants is to be confirmed seven (7) days prior to the event.

Cancellation. Due to the limited number of Monday outings available we require a 90 day notice of cancellation without penalty. This will give the club time to try booking an alternate outing. In the event that the outing is canceled after this period the \$5,000 deposit will be forfeited.

Weather: In the event of a cancellation the club will make every effort to reschedule a mutually convenient date. In the event of lightening or dangerous conditions, the golf staff will suspend play. The decision to resume play will be made by the Rolling Hills Golf Staff. All decisions are final and the Sponsor will hold the Club and or its employees harmless of any decisions. If play is unable to be resumed, and there are no available dates to reschedule your event the following rules will apply for billing. If the group fails to tee off, no golf fees will be charged. One or more holes will result in a 9 hole guest and cart fee. Playing more than 9 holes will be considered a full round. The Club will try to reschedule your outing if there is an available date. In the event of cancellation due to dangerous conditions, all food and beverage will be produced; all food and beverage portion of outing will be offered inside the club and will be charged as per the original contract arrangements.



OUTING FEES

The Golf Outing Fee includes: Greens Fee, Golf Outing Fee, Caddies, Cart set up, Range Fees Pro Shop Opening Fes, Professional Fees, and merchandise purchased for prizes. Charges for golf shop purchases will be taxed. When given enough time, merchandise can be customized with your company's logo upon request.

All Food and Beverage charges are subject to 22% service charge and 6.35% CT State sales tax.

CLUBHOUSE AND CLUB RULES

The Club looks forward to hosting your event. In order to make it an enjoyable visit for your guests; please inform them of the following:

Conduct: Rolling Hills is a family club; guests are expected to conduct themselves as Ladies and Gentlemen. Inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated.

Alcoholic Beverages: No alcoholic beverages are to be brought on Club property. All State laws governing the sale and use of alcohol will be enforced.

Locker Rooms: Men's and Women's locker rooms are provided for your guests. Showers and changing rooms are available. Guests are requested to use these facilities for all changing of attire and to store personal property.

Dress Code: Proper attire is required at all times, on the golf course and in and around the clubhouse:

- a. For men, proper attire is a tucked-in golf shirt and slacks or golf shorts. Jeans and cargo pants of any type are not acceptable attire. Golf shorts must be Bermuda-length. Swimsuits, running shorts, denim shorts, cargo shorts, tennis shorts or cut-offs are not acceptable attire. Hats may not be worn backwards or sideways.
- b. For women, proper attire is a golf shirt or golf tee shirt, slacks, golf shorts, skorts and capris. Jogging suits, swimsuits, cargo pants or shorts, running shorts, short shorts; halter-tops, tennis shorts, cut-offs, or tennis dresses are not acceptable attire. Hats may not be worn backwards or sideways.
- c. Shoes designed specifically for golf must be worn at all times; metal spikes are not allowed. All other shoes are not acceptable attire.

Duration: We want you to enjoy your time at Rolling Hills. At the conclusion of the outing, guests are requested to leave the Club premises within a reasonable period of time.



GOLF INFORMATION

Reserved Starting Times: Are required and may be arranged by calling the Golf Shop after receiving your approval date. Guests must be ready to play at the scheduled Starting time, and at an acceptable pace, or they may forfeit their use of the golf course.

Practice Area: Rolling Hills has a driving range, putting green and a chipping green available for practice. Warm up and practice is restricted to these areas only.

Carts: All carts must be operated in a careful and conscientious manner. Reckless driving will not be permitted under any circumstances.

Caddies: Please check with the Golf Shop on availability of caddies.

Golf Clubs: Rentals are available through the Golf Pro Shop.

TENNIS INFORMATION

Reserved Starting Times: are required for play on the Club's tennis courts and may be arranged by calling the Tennis Pro Shop after receiving your approval date. Please ask to speak with Xavier Proulx, Head Tennis professional. Starting times may be scheduled at any time during your outing hours and may continue until your outing's conclusion.

Dress Code: Proper tennis attire is to be worn on the courts; no running type shoes, cut-off jeans, basketball shorts or golf shorts. Men may wear un-collared shirts provided they are "tennis specific." Tank tops and tee shirts are not acceptable attire for men. This dress code applies to all age groups including children. If further clarification is needed please contact the Tennis Professional.

Tennis Outing Fees: Tennis court fees are \$75.00 per player with a four-person minimum. The tennis outing fee includes: court fee; merchandise purchased for prizes; and administration of either an outing tournament or round robin.

Clinics/private lessons for outings are available at \$65.00 an hour. Cans of balls may be purchased through the Tennis Pro Shop for \$5.00 a can.

Towels are available at no cost from the Tennis Pro Shop. They must be signed out and returned or a \$10.00 towel fee will be charged. Please do not use towels from the locker rooms on the tennis courts.
