ABOUT US

Established in 1961, Rolling Hills was founded by a group of members of Longshore Country Club in Westport after the Town of Westport purchased the club. The closure of Longshore as a private club created a need for a country club to serve the communities of Westport and Norwalk. The former members of Longshore met at the New England Hotel in Westport (now the Westport Inn) for their first meetings and decided upon a parcel of land to construct their new clubhouse and golf course. This land (the current site of RHCC) was acquired from the historic Ambler Farm in Wilton. This sprawling parcel of land is distinguished by its scenic rolling hills, which inspired the Club's name.

Today Rolling Hills is a diverse, family-oriented and inclusive country club that provides its membership with superior golf and racquets programs all based on having first class facilities and dedicated professionals with long teaching experience. Rolling Hills offers dining and recreation year-round, with sledding, cross-country skiing and s'mores in the winter, as well as popular events like the Holiday Luncheons and a Brunch Buffet with a visit by Santa. As the only golf course in Wilton, CT, Rolling Hills is integral to the community, serving as the Wilton High School Golf and Tennis teams' home location as well as hosting fundraisers and business professional events for local organizations held both on the golf course and in the clubhouse.

Rolling Hills Country Club features an 18-hole championship golf course, a six-lane swimming pool, eight tennis courts (four newly lighted), a 300-seat ballroom, casual and formal dining rooms, two outdoor patios and a bar/lounge. RHCC has a reputation for great food and service, whether it's a la carte dining on the popular patio during the summer or a member-sponsored function in our ballroom. An expansive renovation project completed in 2009 has modernized and updated the clubhouse making it one of the premier clubhouses in the area. The club was thrilled to announce the opening of three paddle tennis courts, a beautifully appointed warming hut and a fire pit in December of 2014. The members of Rolling Hills are very proud of the facility and the amenities, especially the golf course, overall quality of service and food and beverage options.

The club is excited about the addition of a new, state-of-the-art, year round training center featuring the latest technology to improve our member's golf game. The training center is scheduled to open late spring 2015.

CLUBHOUSE

Rolling Hills members enjoy three separate dining rooms, in addition to the ballroom and patio, which offer intimate settings for a formal or casual dining experience.

RHCC children have their own Youth Activities Room with professional youth coordinators to organize are on hand to organize meals and activities for the youngest members of the club. Every Friday night is Kids Night Out, when RHCC staff take care of children in the Youth Activities Room, while adults eat in the dining rooms (or adults may choose to dine with their children in one of our dining rooms). The Youth Activities Room features foosball, ping pong and Wii games.

The clubhouse renovation has updated the men's and ladies locker rooms into premier country club locker rooms. Additionally, the new clubhouse has a state of the art conference room that is the perfect venue for an off-site business meeting.
